

FY 2018 Public Records Highlights

Number of Requests Received and Closed in FY2018


The University of Iowa received **741** public records requests for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. After three years of increases, the number of requests held steady compared to last year, when 742 requests were received. 736 requests were closed in FY2018, including 24 requests that were still pending at the end of FY2017. Requests completed with responsive documents totaled 623. Records weren't available for 37 requests, 55 requests were withdrawn or deactivated due to lack of payment, and 21 requests were denied. 29 requests received in FY2018 were still pending at the close of the fiscal year.






Response Times

In keeping with our commitment to respond efficiently and expeditiously to all public records requests, **80** percent of requests were completed within 10 business days, and **90** percent were completed within 20 business days.



Requests Received by Category


The top five most requested categories remained the same as last year, with the category of **Public Safety** (which includes requests for police incident and accident reports) once again making up the largest share of public records requests, with 203 (27% of the total requests received). **Student Services** was the second most requested category, which saw an increase of 11% over last year (from 140 to 156). In addition to requests for student directory lists and student data/statistics, two recurring requests for the updated list of books adopted for use at the IMU Book Store are also included in this category. **Athletics** (including coaches' contracts and athletics financial reports) was the third leading category, with the number of requests holding steady compared to FY2017. Requests related to **Purchasing** (such as bid proposals and vendor contracts) and **Human Resources** once again rounded out the top five most requested categories.

Affiliation of Requestors

177 of the 741 requests received in FY2018 came from the media: 123 from lowa reporters, and 54 from out-of-state reporters. 262 requests came from businesses/vendors (including bidders, insurance agencies, and companies requesting student directory information), an 8% decrease from last year's 286 requests. Other common requestors included attorneys (41 requests), individuals affiliated with other colleges/universities (30 requests), and labor unions (including a recurring request from SEIU, processed every three weeks). Private citizens, or individuals with unknown affiliation, accounted for about a fourth of the requests received (189).

Types of Records Requested

In FY2018, requests for data/statistics or lists generated from databases were the most popular type of request. Data was requested on a variety of topics, including purchasing (e.g. purchase orders, lists of outstanding checks), arrests, HR/salary data, and student enrollment/admissions statistics. We received 177 requests for police incident/accident reports, making those reports the second most requested type of record.

Contracts (employment/vendor/construction) were requested by 145 different requestors in FY2018. The most common type of contract requested was employment contracts for coaches and other athletics department staff. 58 requests were for student directory lists (e.g. email addresses for all students enrolled for Fall 2017, mailing addresses for Spring 2018 graduates, etc.), and 55 requests involved gathering emails or other types of correspondence from UI employees.

The single most requested document was Kirk Ferentz's employment contract as head football coach (23 requests). The FY2017 NCAA Financial Report was the most requested report (13 requests). Under the category "Emails/Correspondence," 11 requests were received in FY2018 for the University's correspondence with the Department of Education's Office of Civil Rights.
